Definition of the subjective experience of Provocation

State of attentional, motivational, and emotional tension characterized by the awareness of (a) incompatible values, beliefs, or expectations and (b) agency; pressing need for action.

Examples of activity types for which this scale is appropriate

Following dark tourism site visits, provocative speeches about political issues, reading material designed to move people to action.
